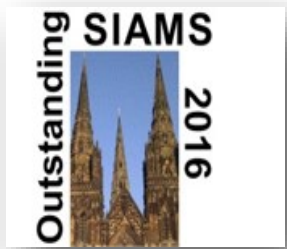

## Dear Parents and Carers,

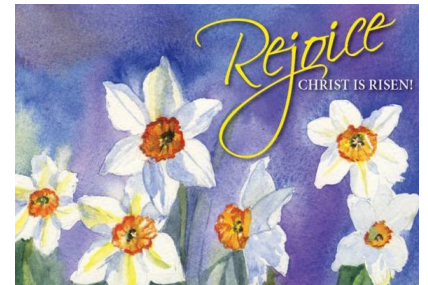
We are now at the end of what has been a challenging term for us all however, as a school community, we have worked together, supporting one another, as we always do at St. Paul's.

## Parent's Association

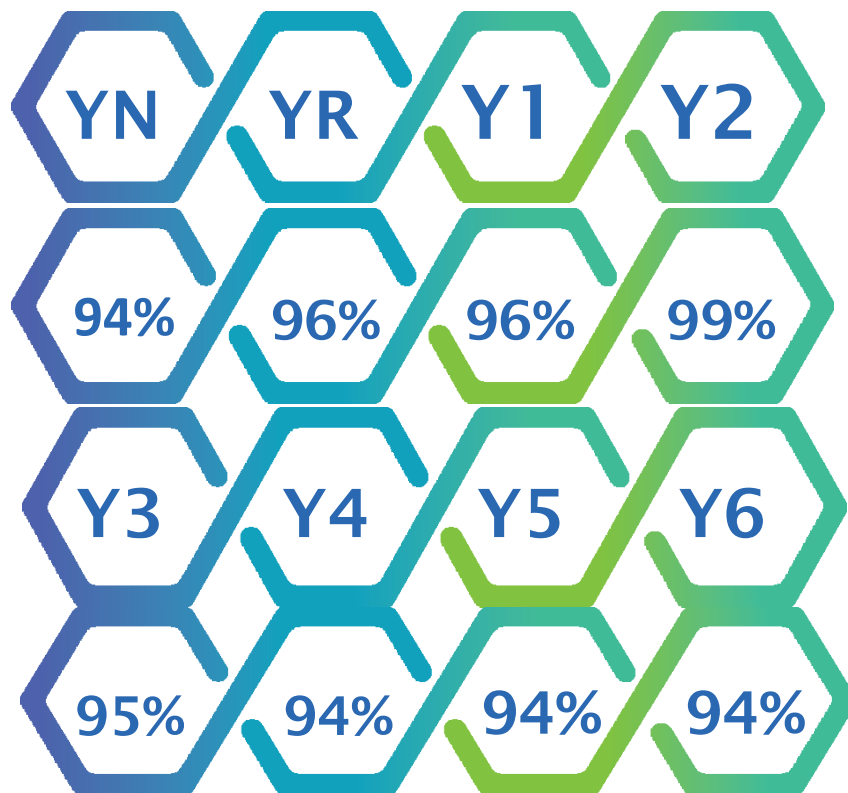

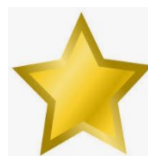
