Welcome to the first edition of our termly TTRS newsletter. In this newsletter you will find out about all the latest times table news and look back at what we have achieved over the term.

Having launched TTRS new this year, it has been great to see how much the children have enjoyed using it and the progress they have all made so far has been amazing, which I'm sure you will all agree.

Our leader boards are changed each week on a Friday, where we have a hustle of children gathered round the board to see if they have made the top 30 that week. The leaderboard includes the child with the highest earned coins, the child who has answered most of the correct questions in the last 7 days and the child with the most improved rock speed. Each class teacher also chooses a TTRS of the week and they go up on to our leaderboard with a postcard sent home explaining why they have been chosen as the TTRS of the week. Hopefully you will get one come through your door very soon!

As our children have been working very hard we like to celebrate their achievements, which is why we choose one child from the whole school to be the ultimate TTRS of the week and this child will receive a certificate in Friday's worship. They also appear on our weekly newsletter, so keep a look out to see who it is each week.

All class teachers are able to view individual children's progress and use this accordingly to help move the children forward. After looking at the responses from the questionnaire handed out at parents evening, it was identified that not all parents or children knew how to check their individual statistics or the statistics of the class. Below is a brief explanation of how to complete this action but if you are still having problems please come and see me.

Log on to your account ---- click on your icon in the top right hand corner --- select My Stats, which will show you your individual heat map.

To view the statistics of the rest of the class follow these steps;

Log on to your account ---- click on your icon in the top right hand corner --- select My Year --- this will then show you a ranking of your class using only their rock names. You will be able to see the baseline rock speed and their current rock speed, current rock status and how many coins they have.

You should have all had a copy of your child's heat map given to you at parents evening this half term. This highlights in red the questions the children are taking longer to answer. Bright green indicates it is around 1 second per question and red indicates 10 seconds or more per question. Remember our aim is to be a Rock Star – 1 second for every question. You can continue to see an updated version of the heat map on the My Stats section of the online page.

I know a few parents have also had a few issues with logging on using the app version of TTRS. In order for it to be accessed on a table it must be opened via 'Google' or 'Safari' rather than through the app.
