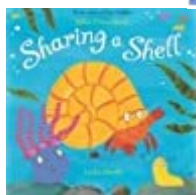
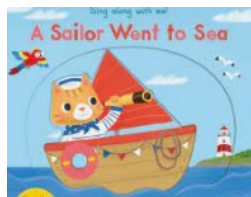
## R.E

This terms focus will be on rhythm and rhyme. The children will be exploring rhyming words through books and songs.



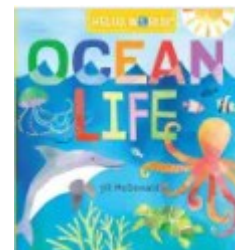
## Mathematics

*Every Day Counts!*



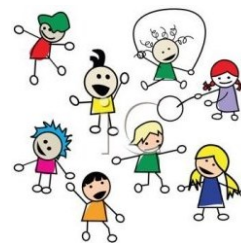
## PE

outdoor area.



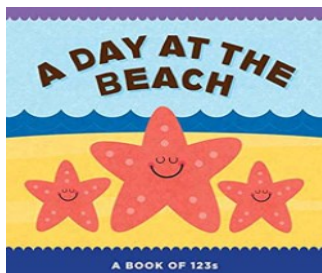
## Homework
