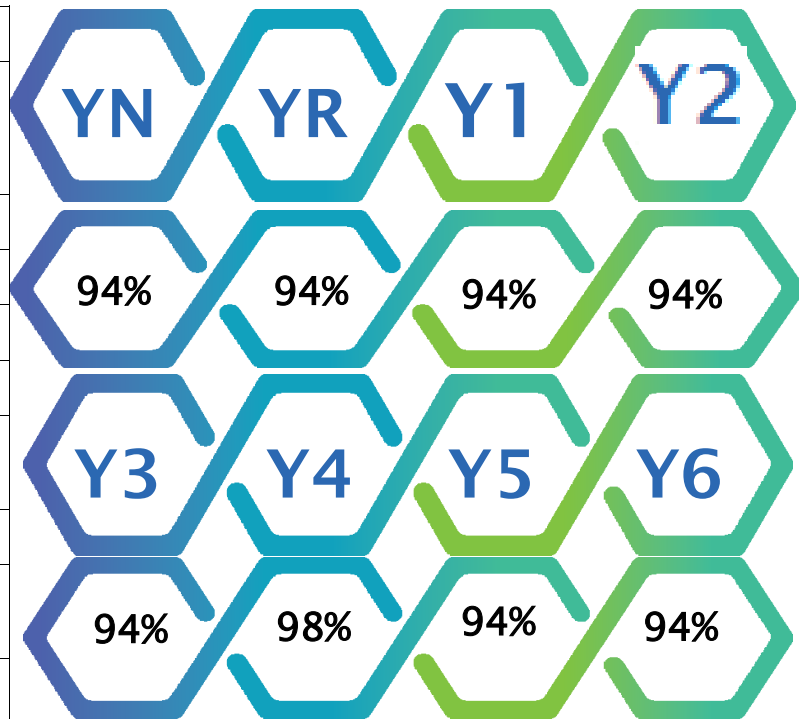

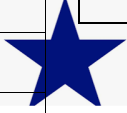
Attendance
