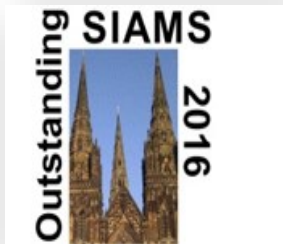

Children in Need Non-Uniform Day

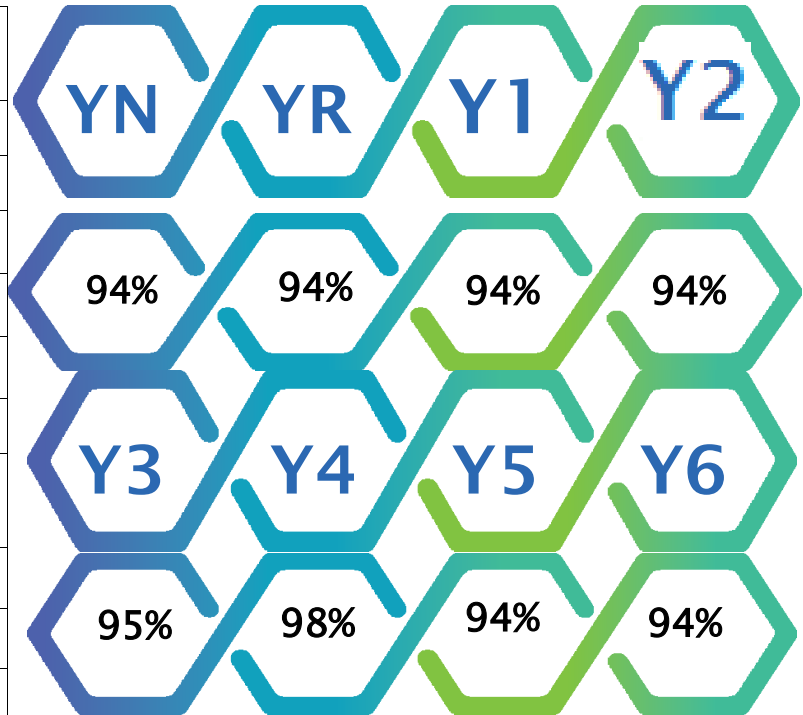
