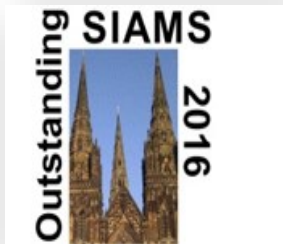

## School Council Raffle

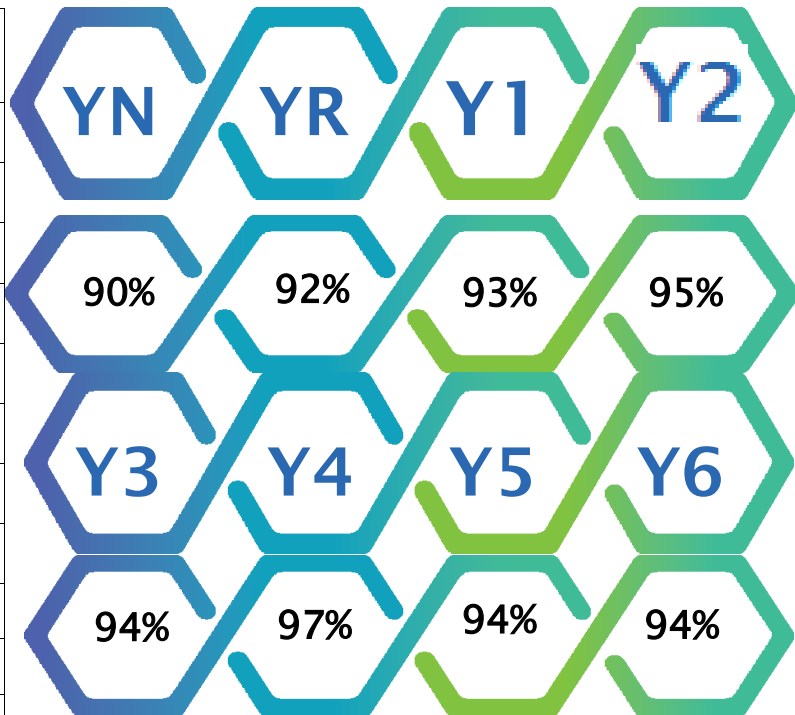
The School Council have raised £165 for their chosen charity, Birmingham Children's Hospital. Thank you to our School Council for their hard work organising the raffle and to all who supported.
