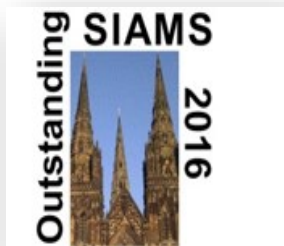

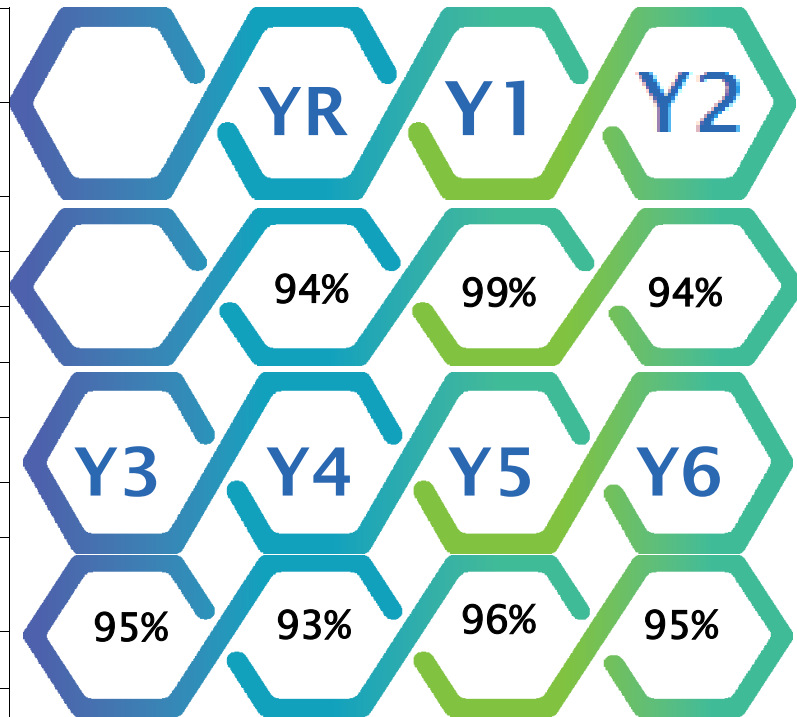
## Friday Worship
