Friday Worship

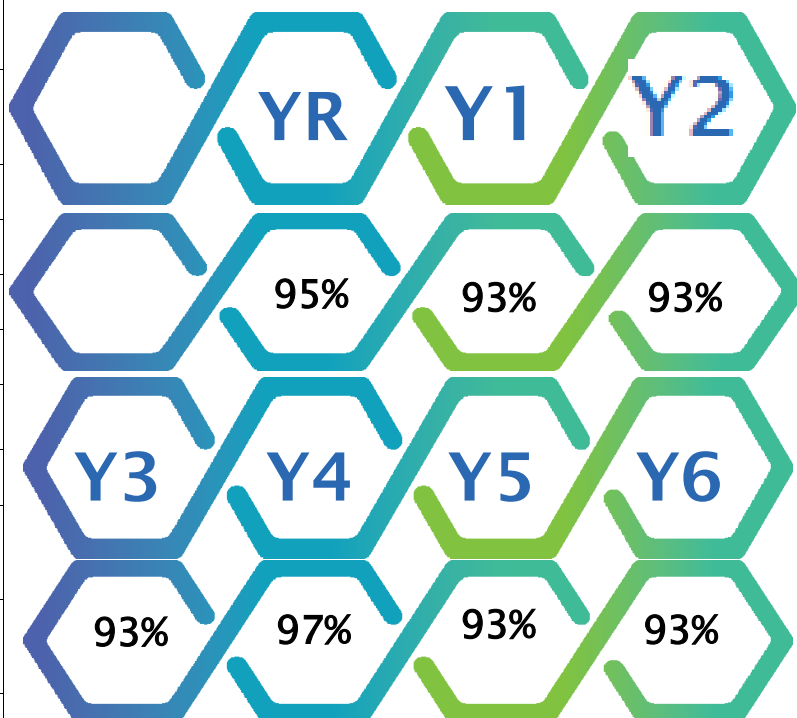
Parents and grandparents are more than welcome to attend our Friday Worship. Principal Awards are given out and children can also bring in certificates achieved from out of school activities.
