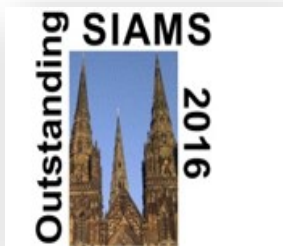

Tickets for the Nativity have been allocated, however we do have a few spare tickets available for the performance on Wednesday 7th December. Please contact the school office for more information.

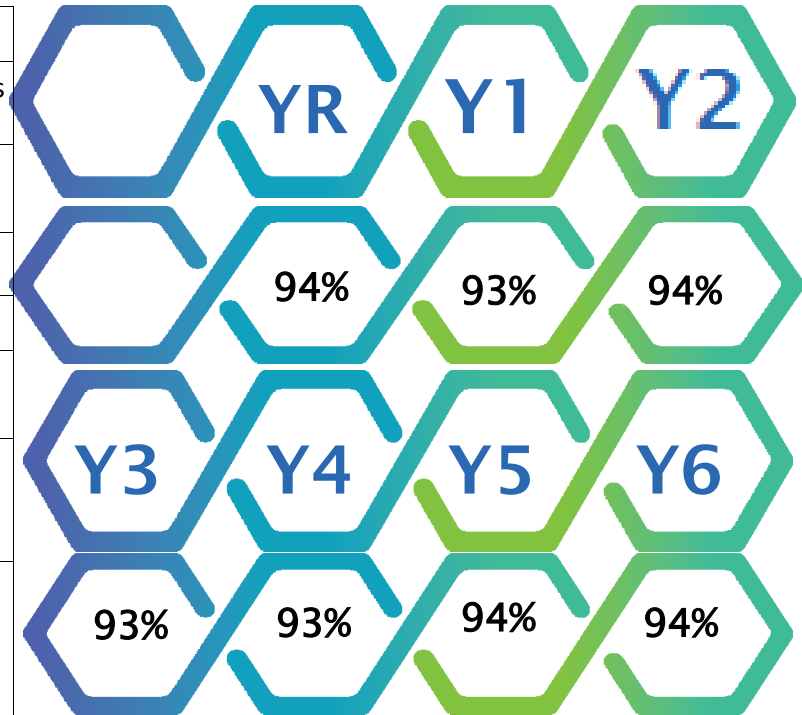
