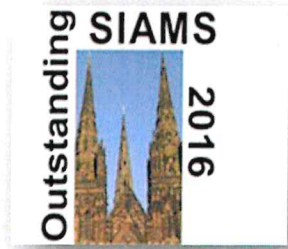

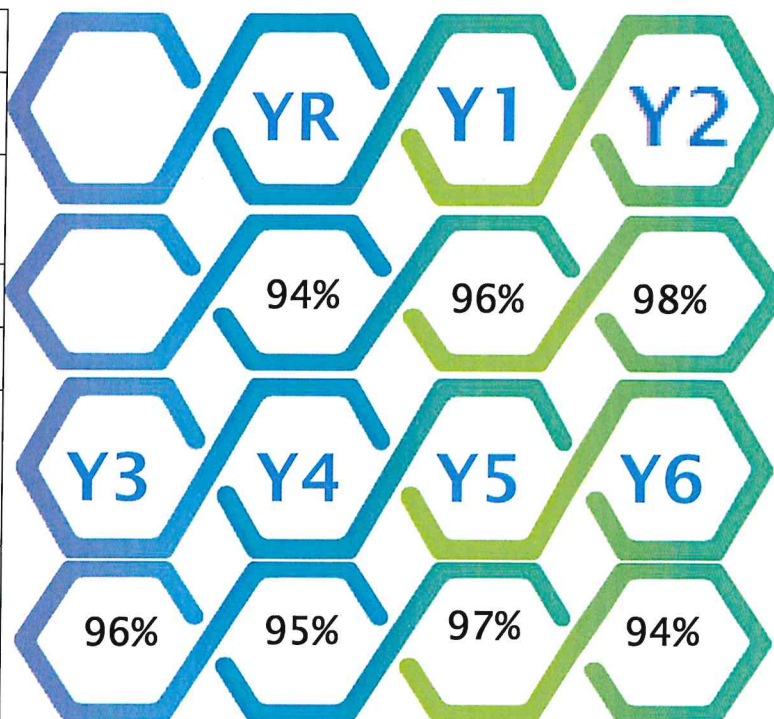
Girls Football Team
