School Council

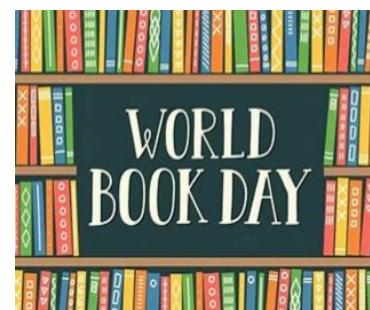
After half term the School Council will be organising some fundraising activities towards the Turkey-Syria Earthquake Appeal. This is part of our Lenten Charity work.

World Book Day

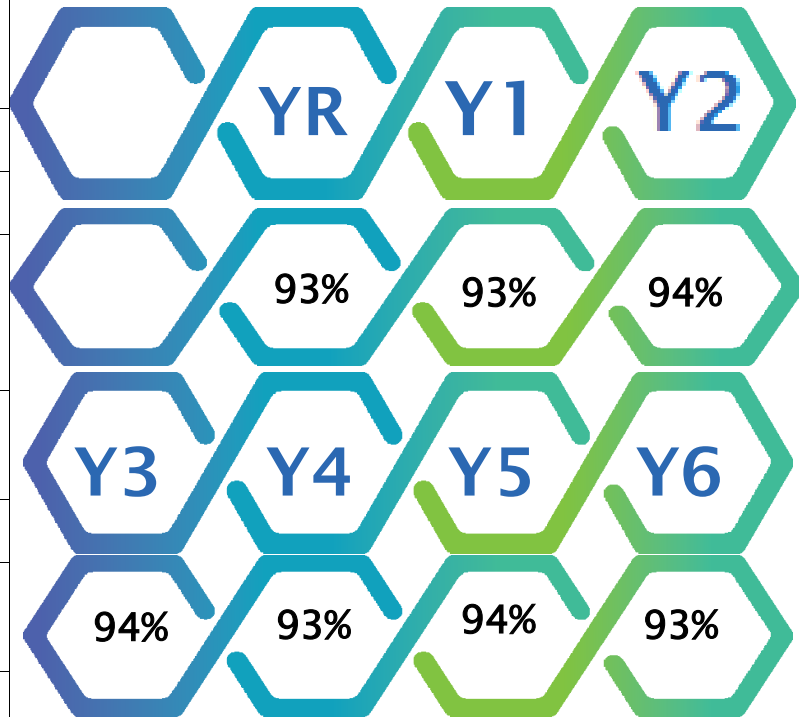
