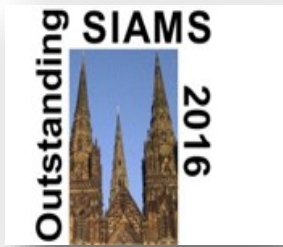

## Staffing

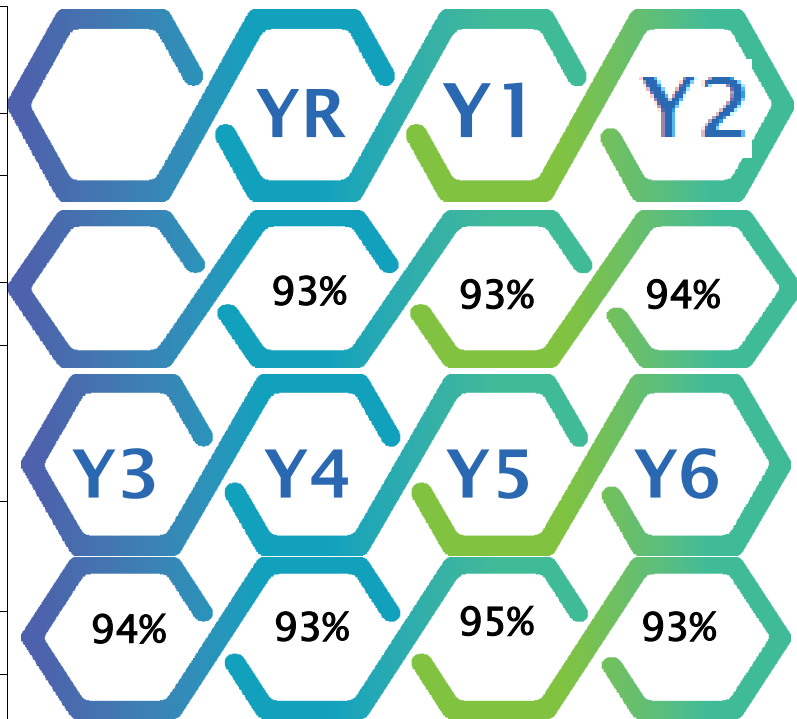
I am sure that you will join me in welcoming back Mrs Collinson who has returned from maternity leave. Mrs Collinson is our Vice Principal
