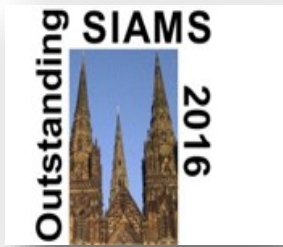

Please ensure that you make an appointment for Parents Evening as soon as possible. Miss Buchray, our SENCo, will also be available on both evenings, if you need to speak to her.

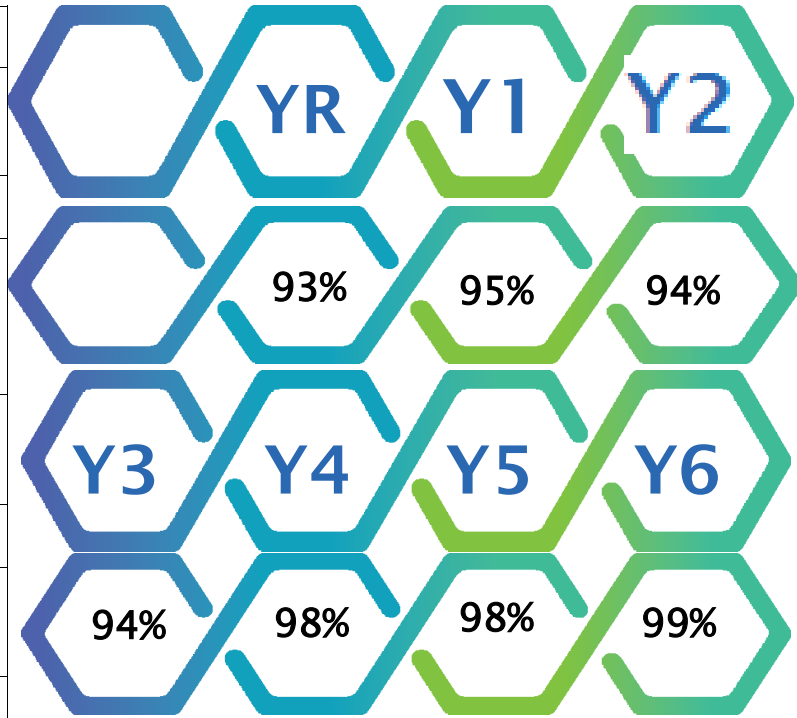
## Easter Celebration

Our Easter Celebration is next Friday 31st March, all are welcome.

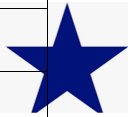
