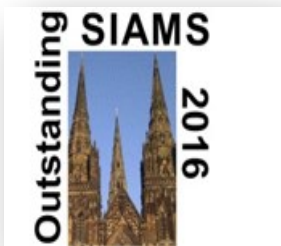

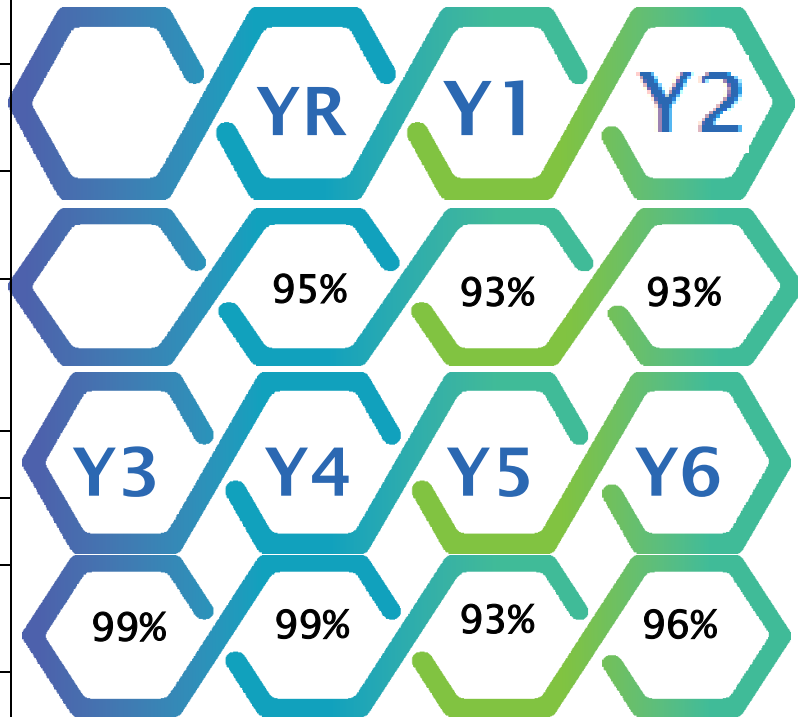
Weduc App
