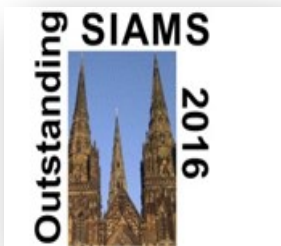

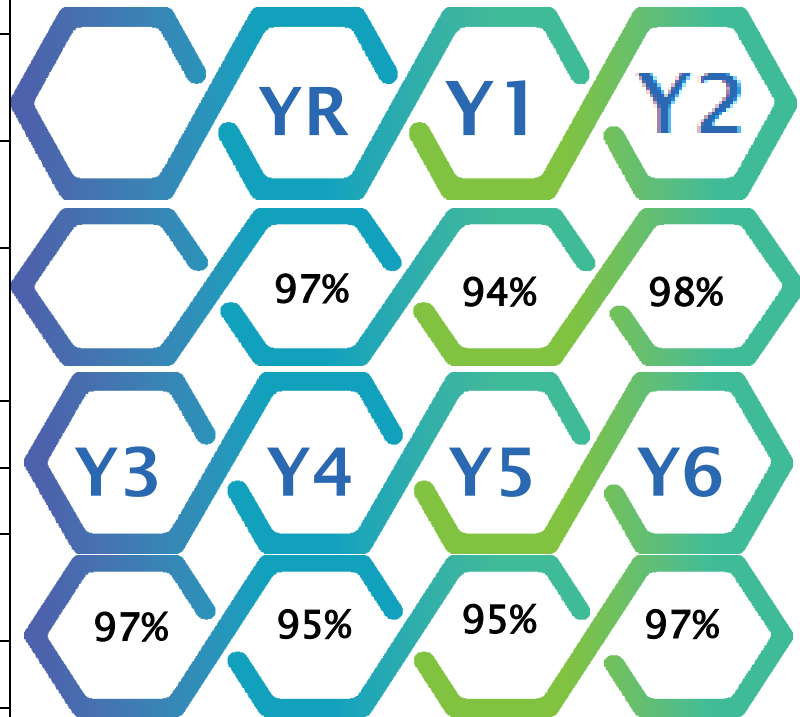
Year Five
