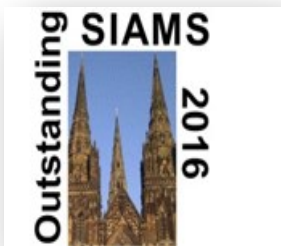

We can now issue food bank vouchers through school, these are from the Black Country Food Bank. Please contact Mrs Hartland via the school office for further information.

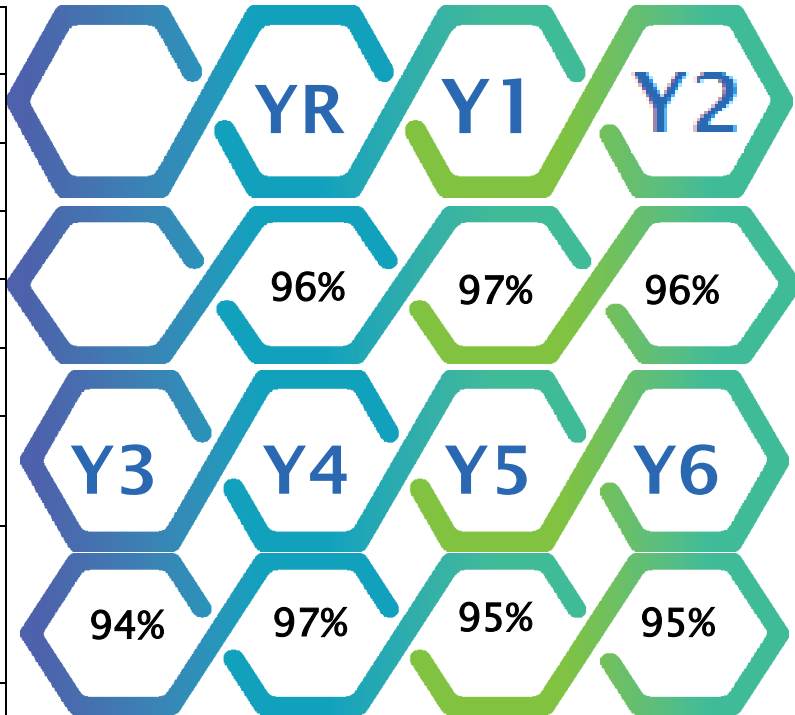
## Marcus Rashford Book Club
