## Macmillan Non Uniform Day Friday 29th September

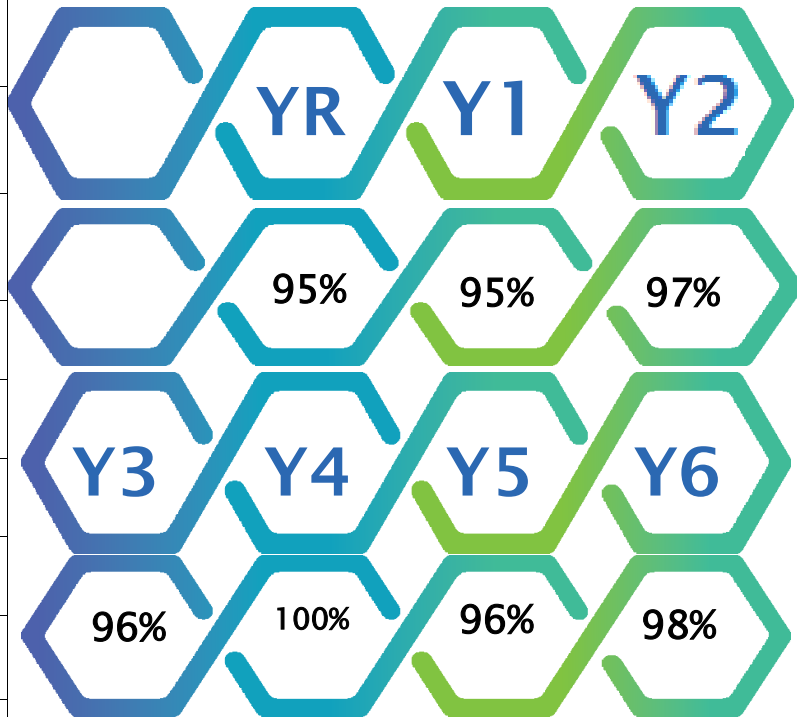
