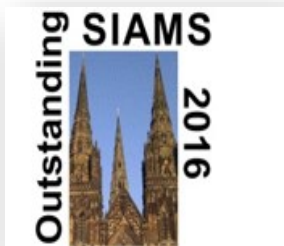

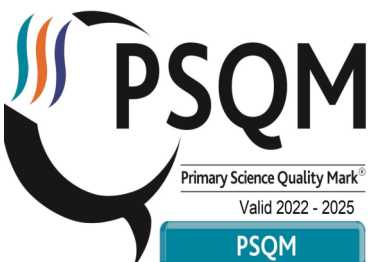


Friday Worship

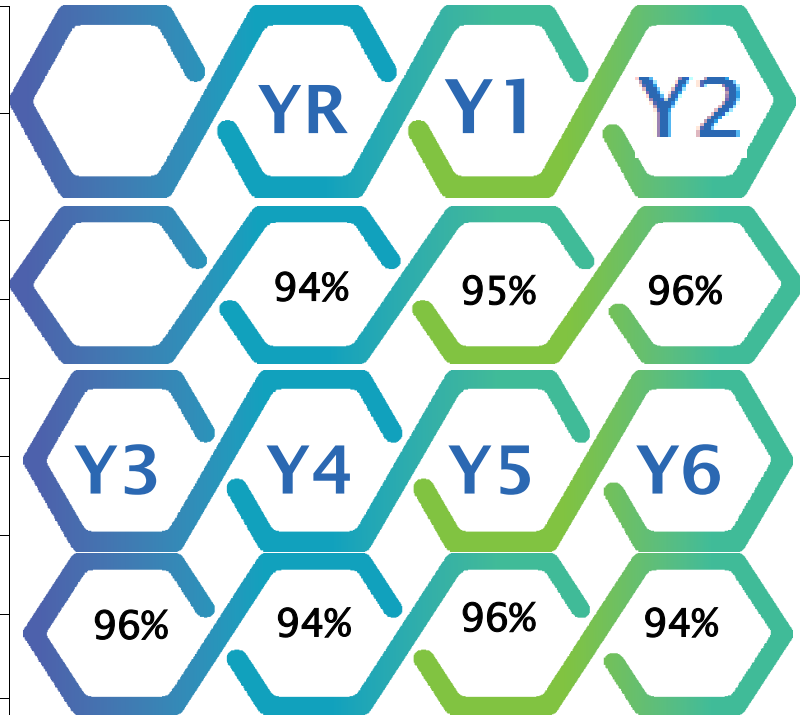

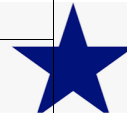
