Start of the School Day

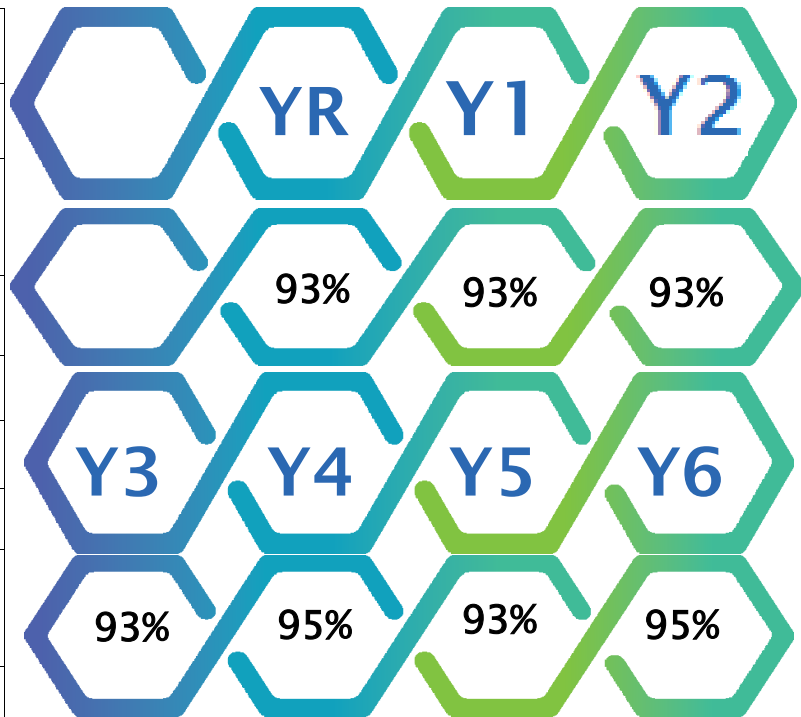
As a polite reminder it is only Reception parents who walk their children round to class at the start of the school day.
