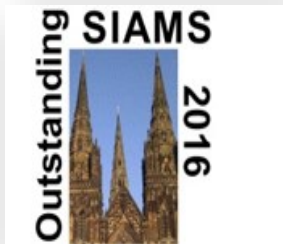

We still have some items of uniform left in school, we have mainly grey trousers and pinafores as well as some white polo tops and shirts. Please contact the school office if you would like any uniform.

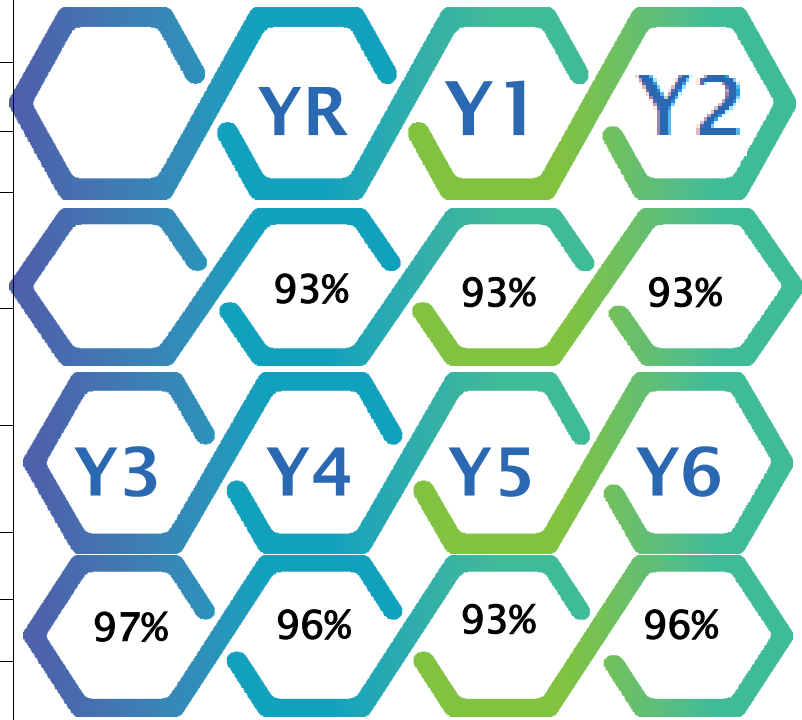
Nativity

If you need any further Nativity tickets we have some spare for the performance on Wednesday 13th December. Please ask at the school office for further information.

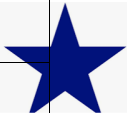
