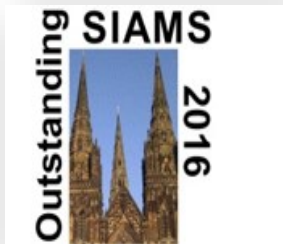

In the spirit of spreading festive cheer, our postbox is now in place for the children to deliver their Christmas cards to their classmates.

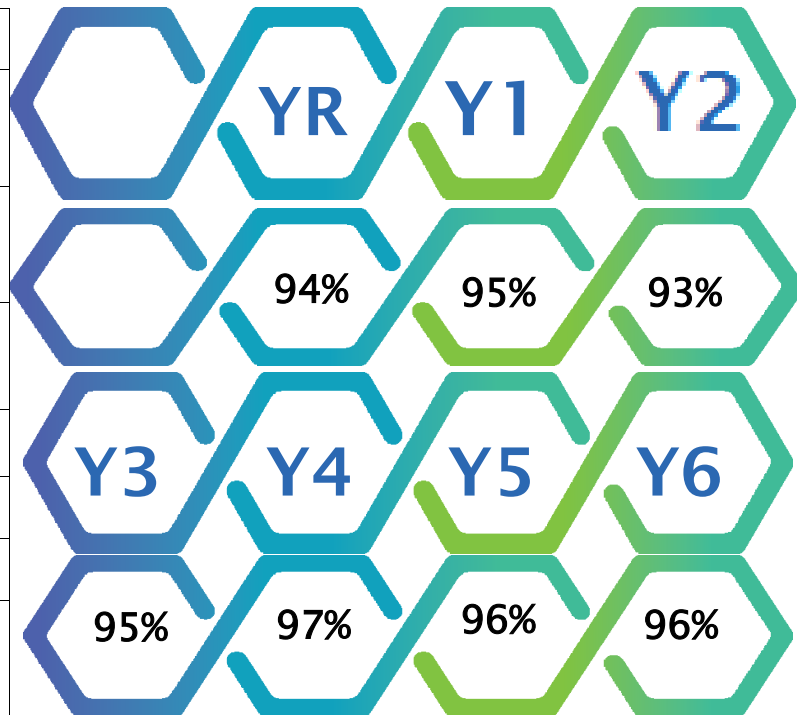

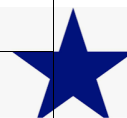
## Attendance
