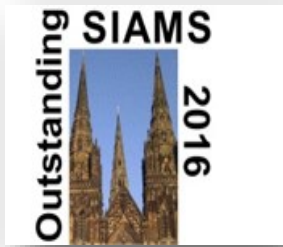

Parent Governor

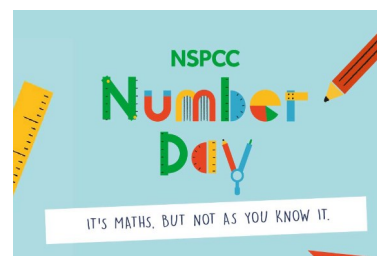

Number Day

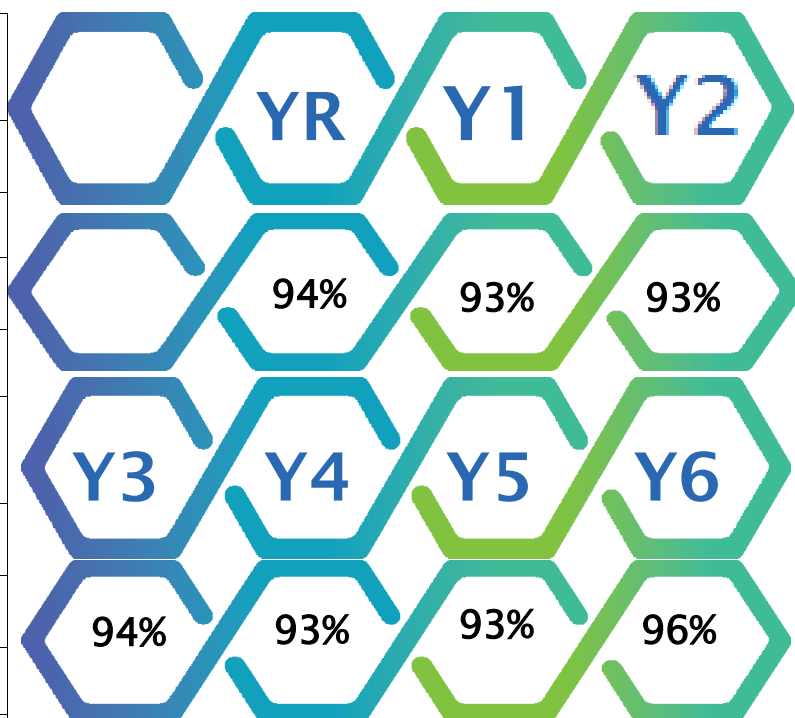
