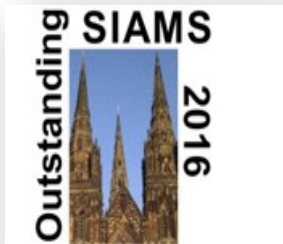

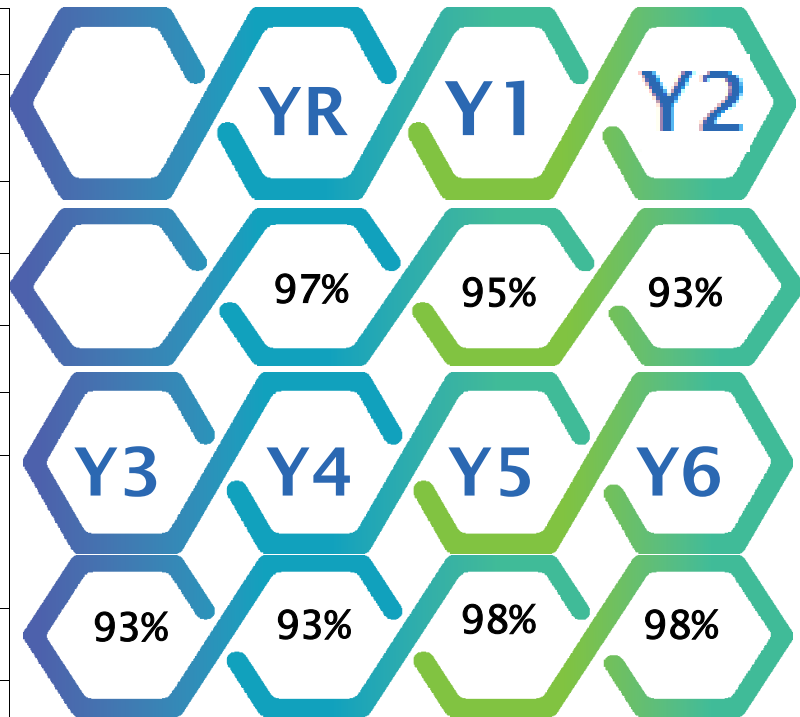
Measles
