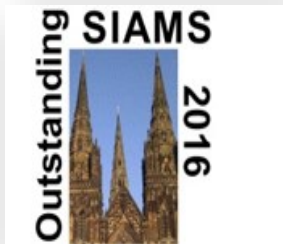




# St Paul's News

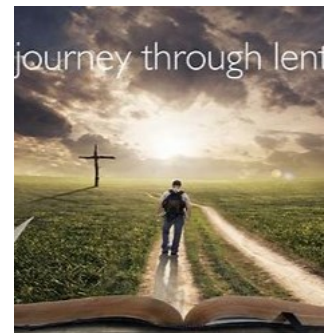

## Reception Easter Bonnet Parade

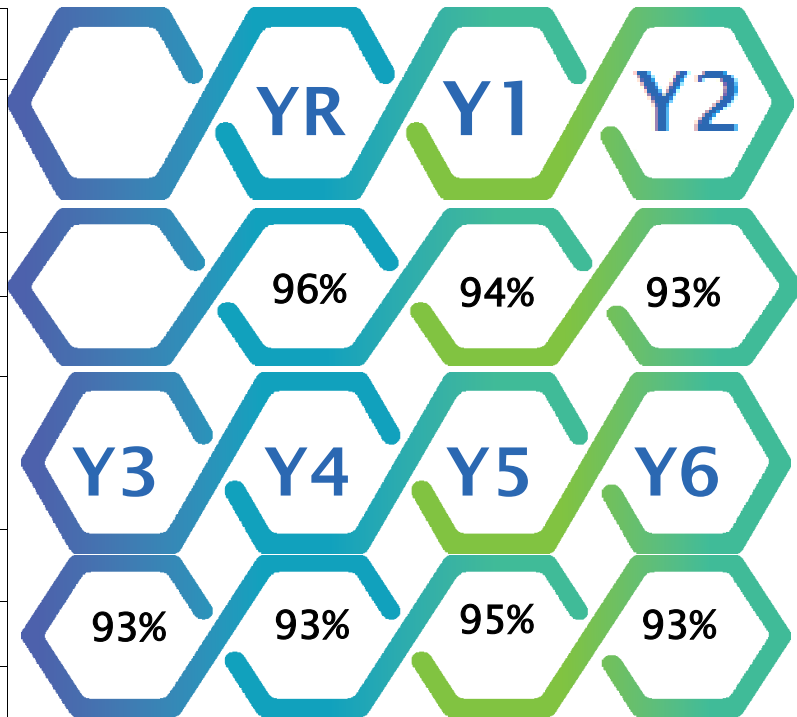
You are welcome to join us for Reception's Easter Bonnet Parade on Tuesday 19th March, this will start at 9.00am in the school hall.



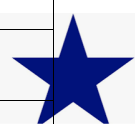

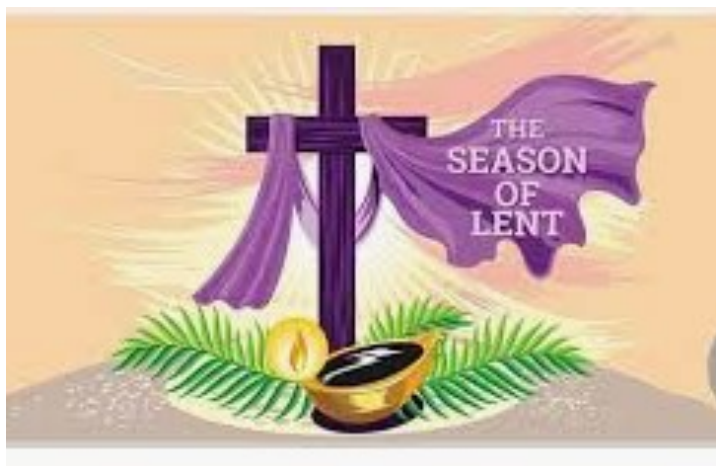
# Attendance
