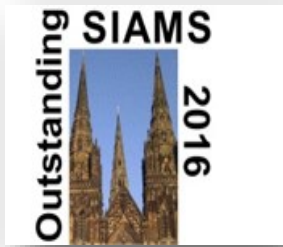

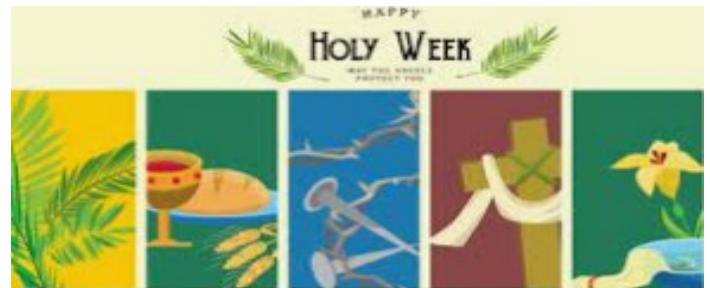
## Dear Parents and Carers,

Please ensure that when we return to school after Easter that your child is in the correct P.E. kit. There should be no football or logo tops worn.

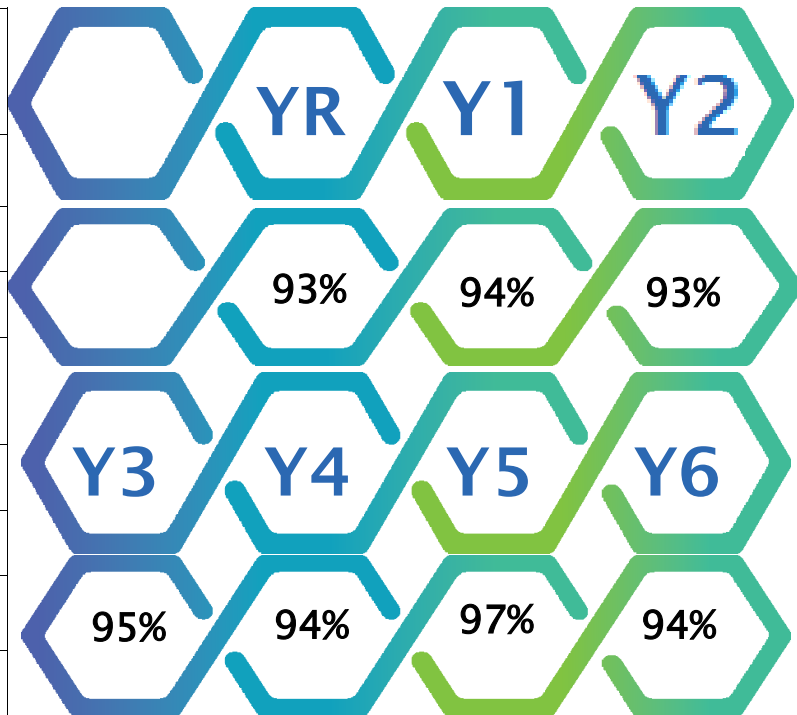
## Uniform
