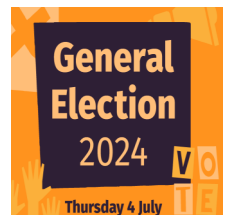

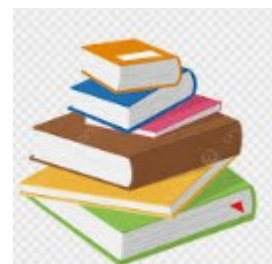
## General Election

## Class Worship

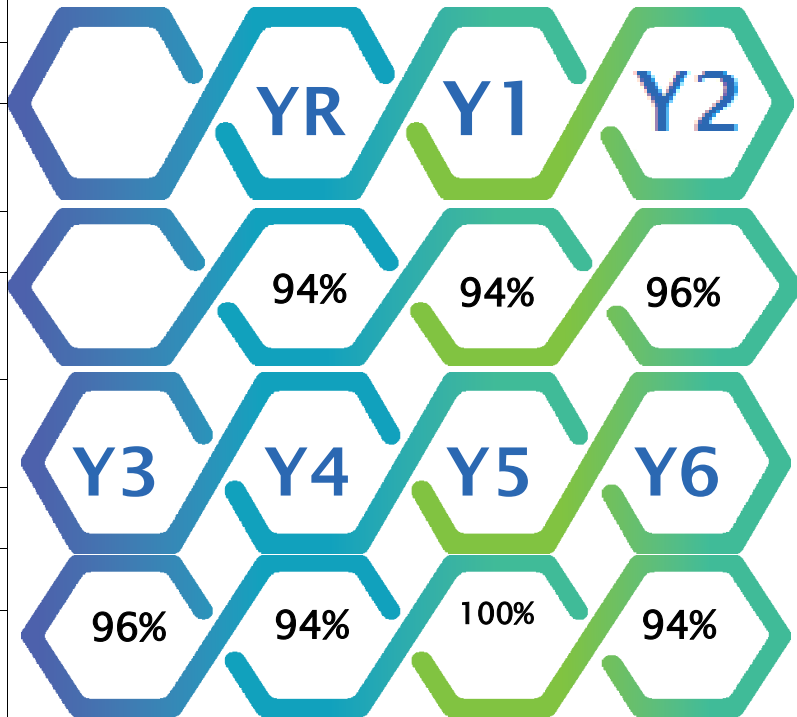
As a reminder next Friday our Year Five class will be leading Worship. The Worship will have a Black Country theme and you are more than welcome to join us.



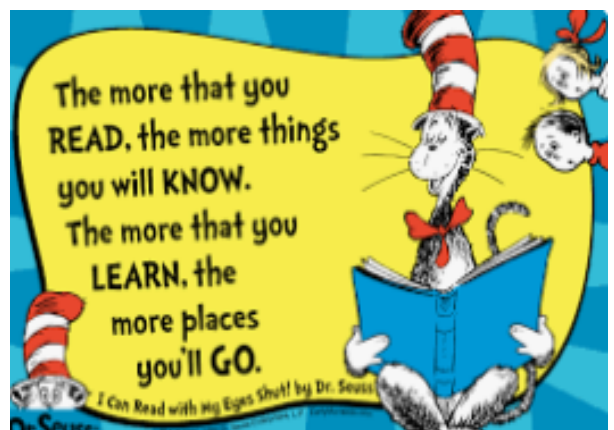
