Reception Graduation and Garden Party

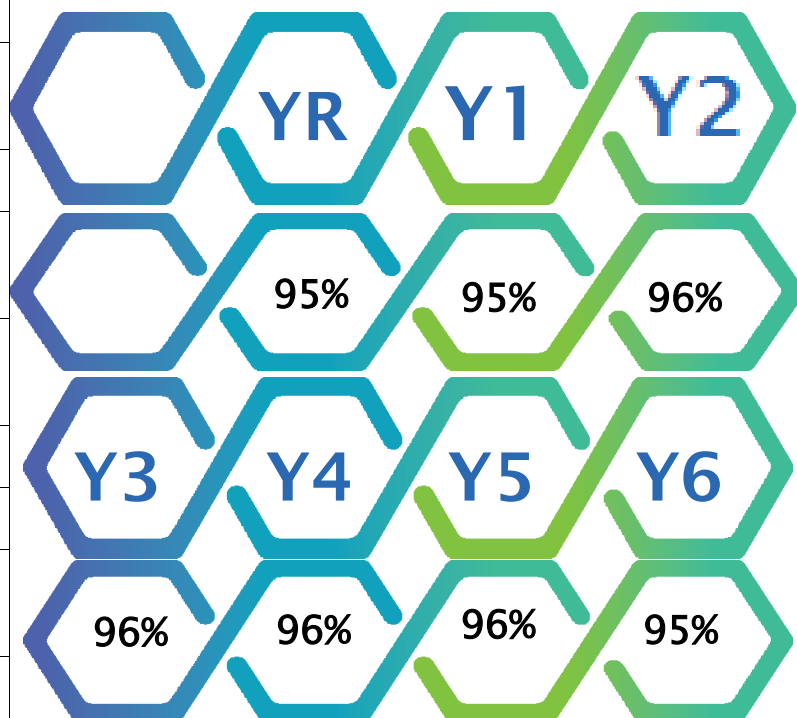
