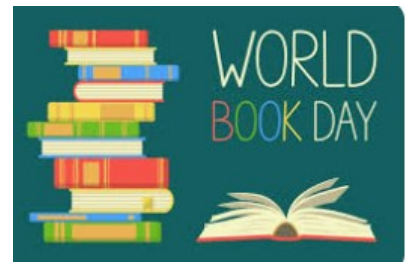
Once again, thank you for your fantastic support in making World Book Day a success! Have a lovely weekend and enjoy the sunshine

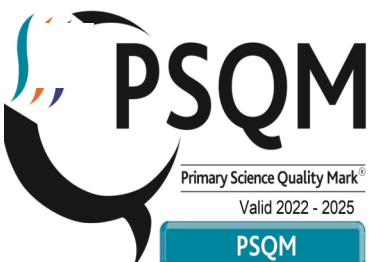

Science Week

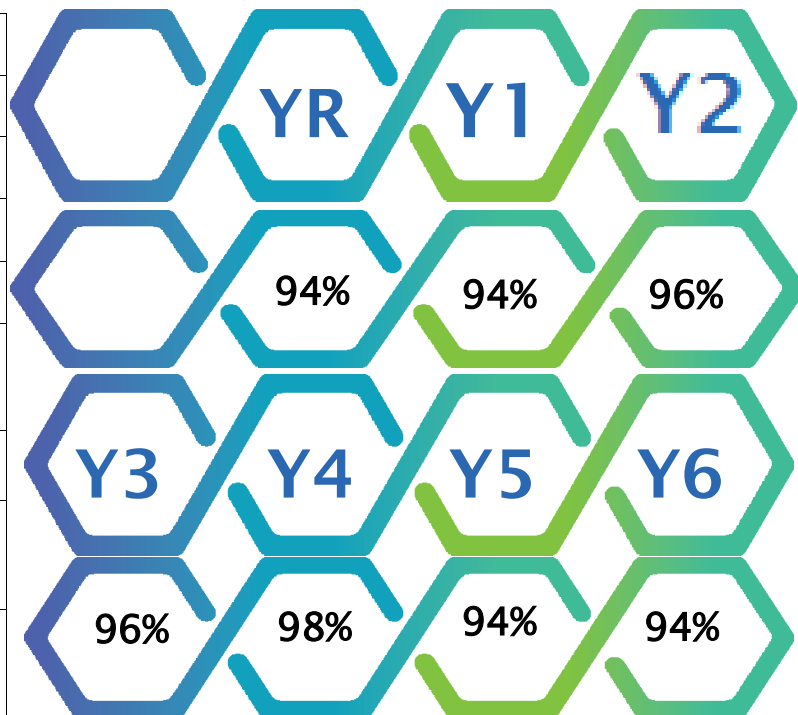

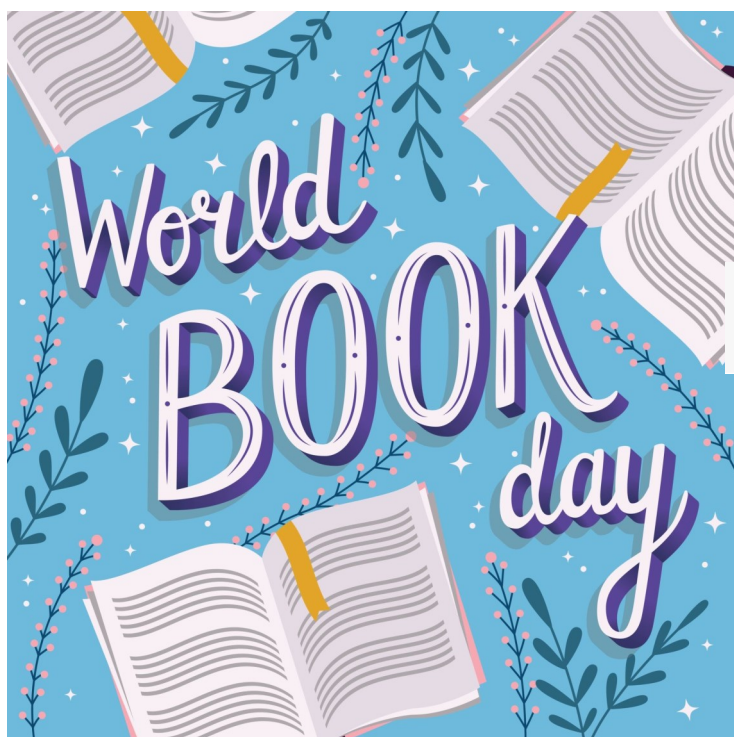
