V. E. Day Celebrations

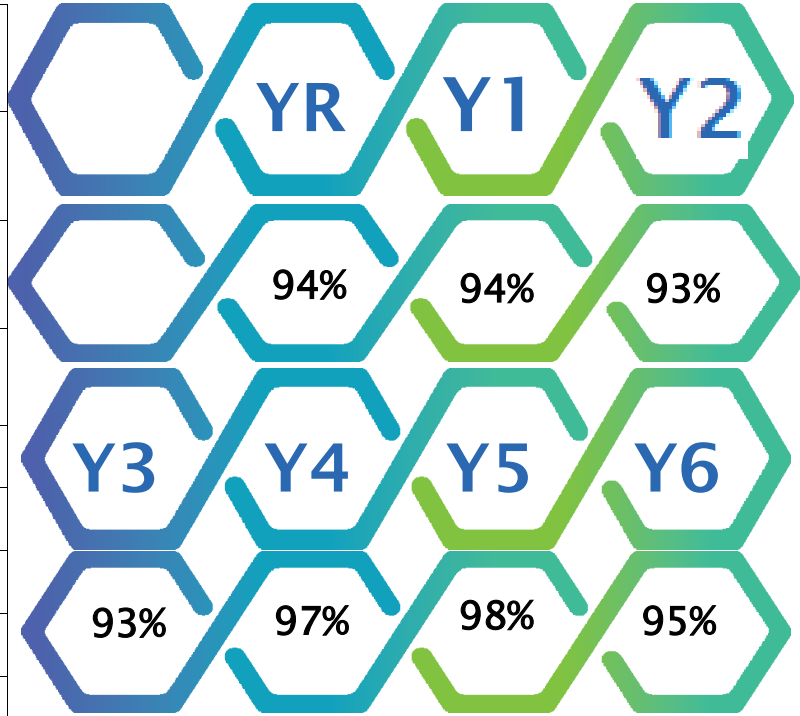

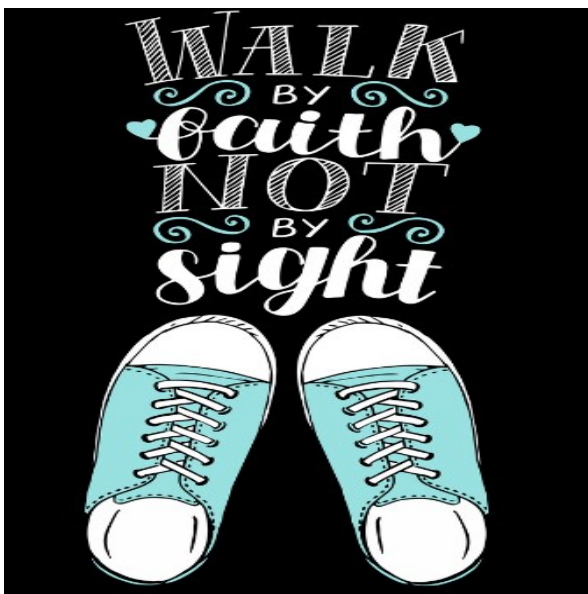
