This year we will be holding our Sports Day on Tuesday 17th June, Reception and Key Stage One Sports will be held in the morning at 9.30 am.


Key Stage Two Sports will start at 1.45 pm. If the weather is wet, the reserve date is Tuesday 24th June with the times remaining the same.
