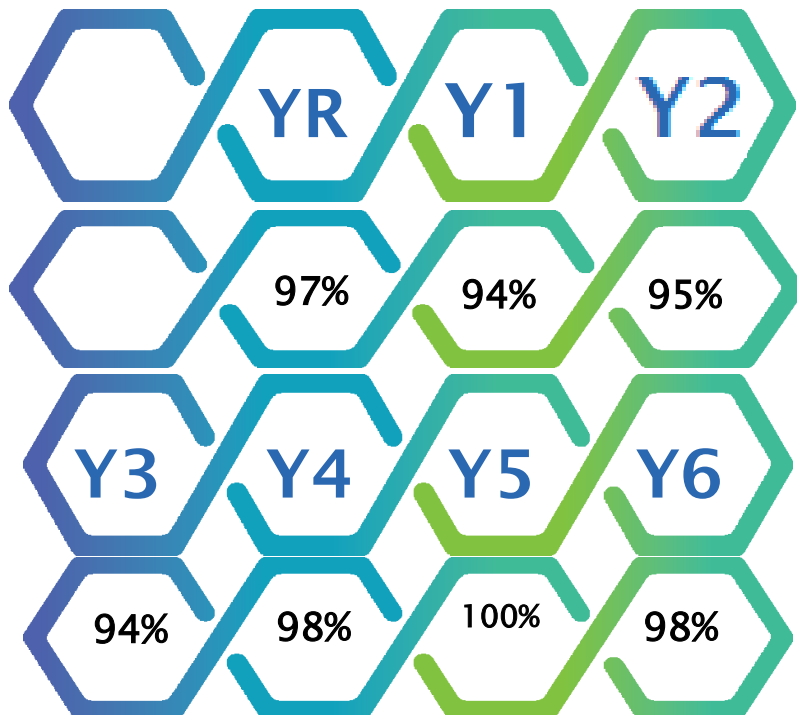

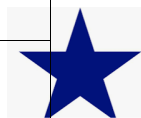
## Attendance
