Friday Worship

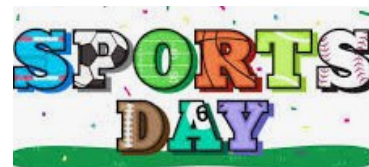
Classes will be leading Worship on the following dates. Parents and carers are more than welcome to attend.

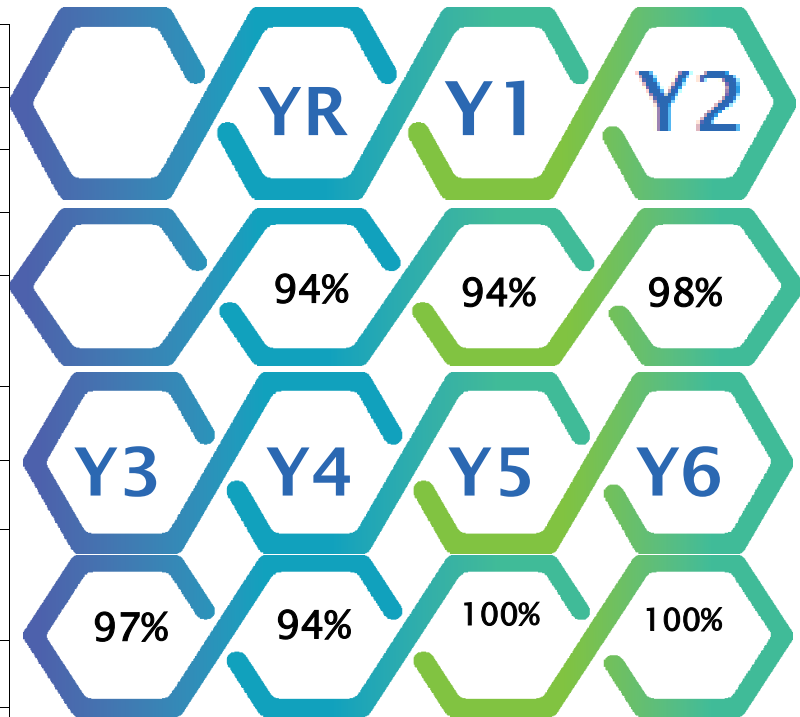
