A Journey Through Ancient Egypt

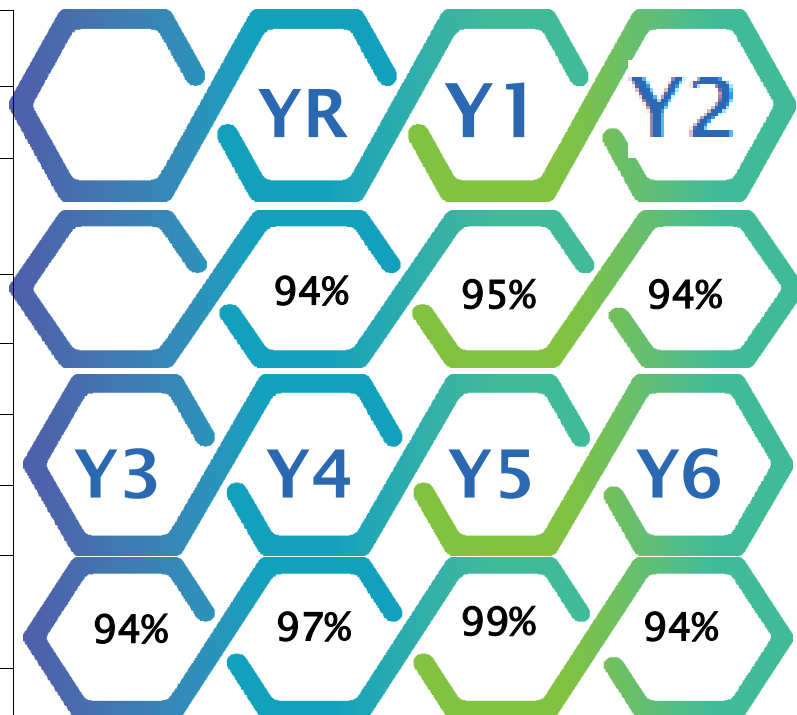
