Attendance Matters

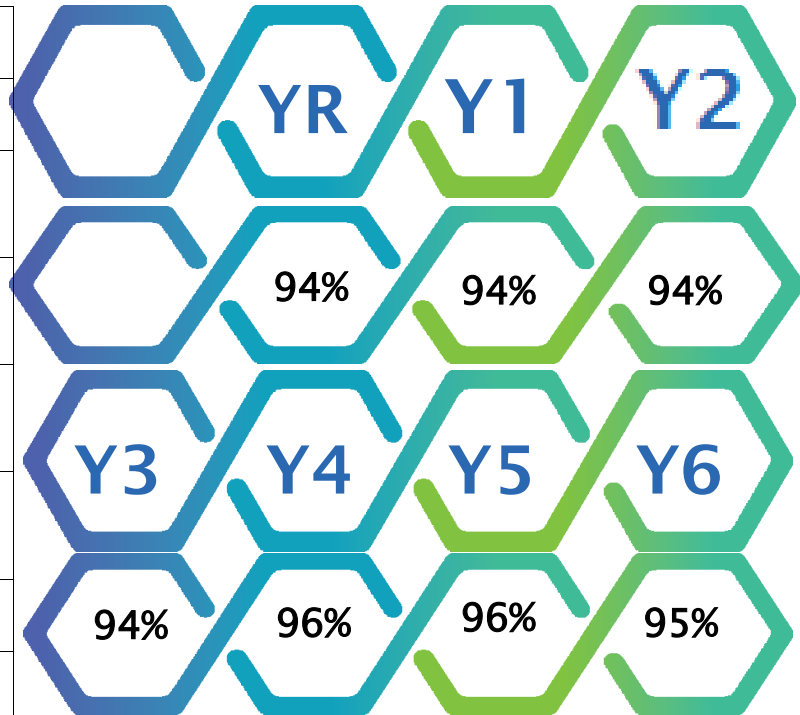
