## Safeguarding

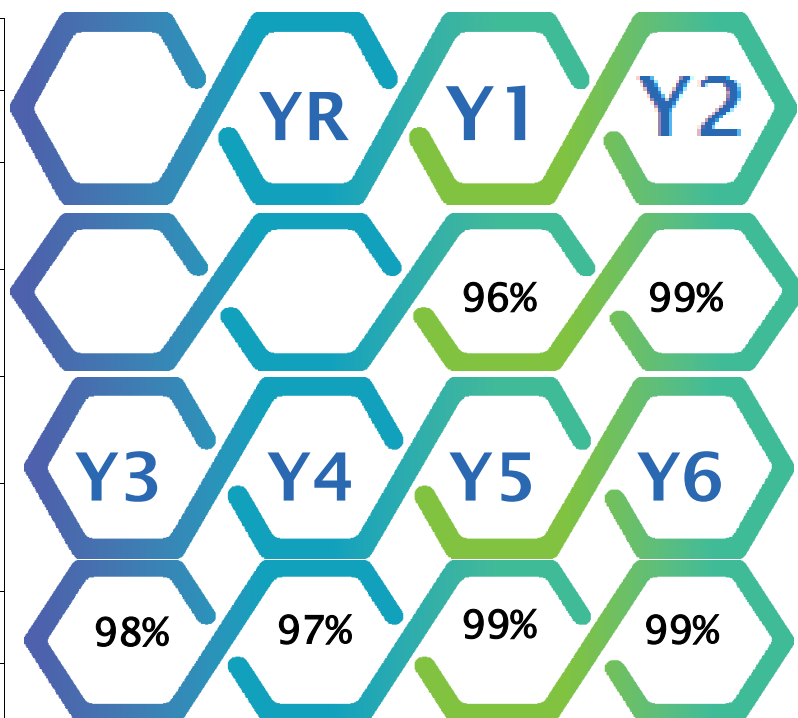
