Non—Uniform Days

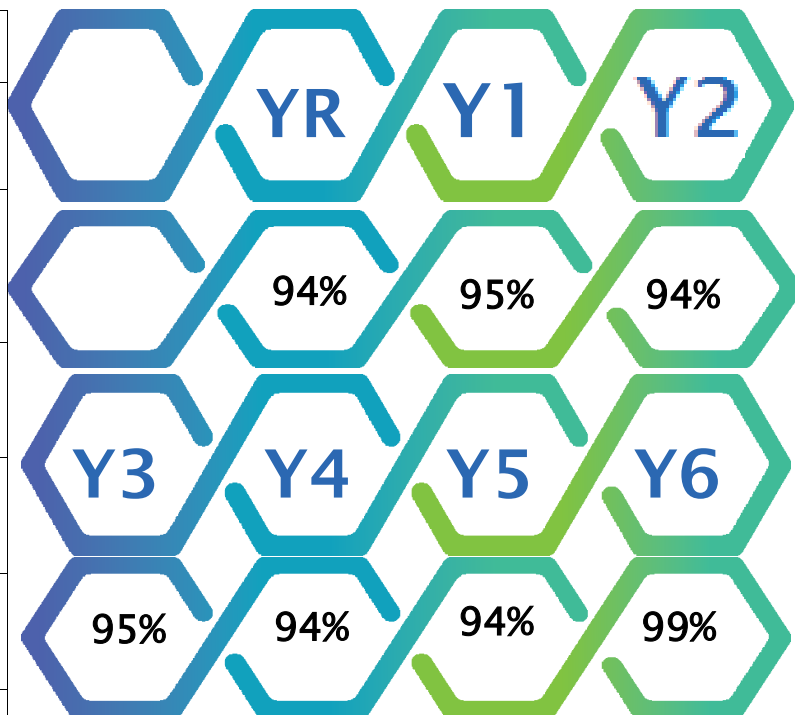
