Extreme Weather

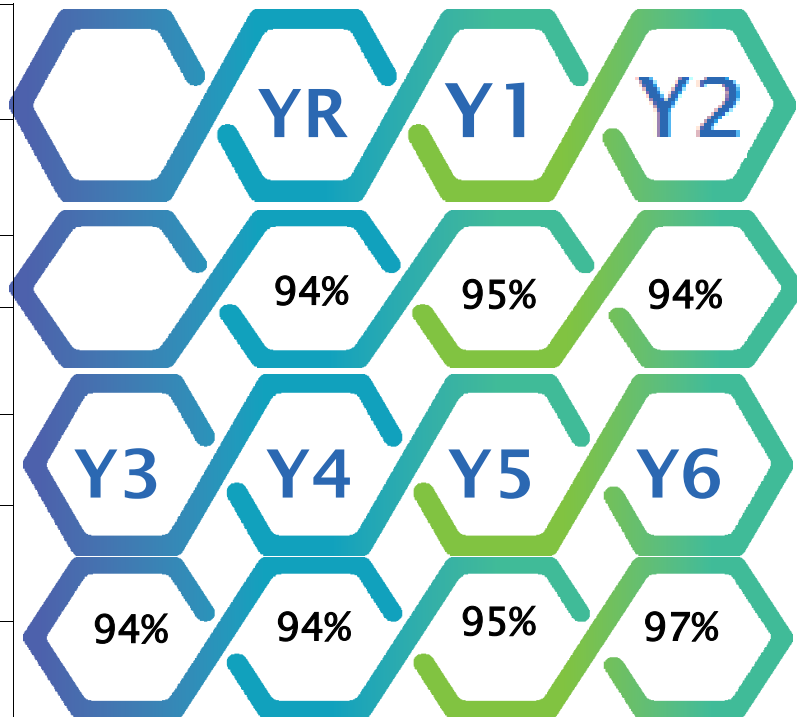
