Please order your child's school meal in advance. If you need any help to do this, please ask at the school office and they will be happy to support you.

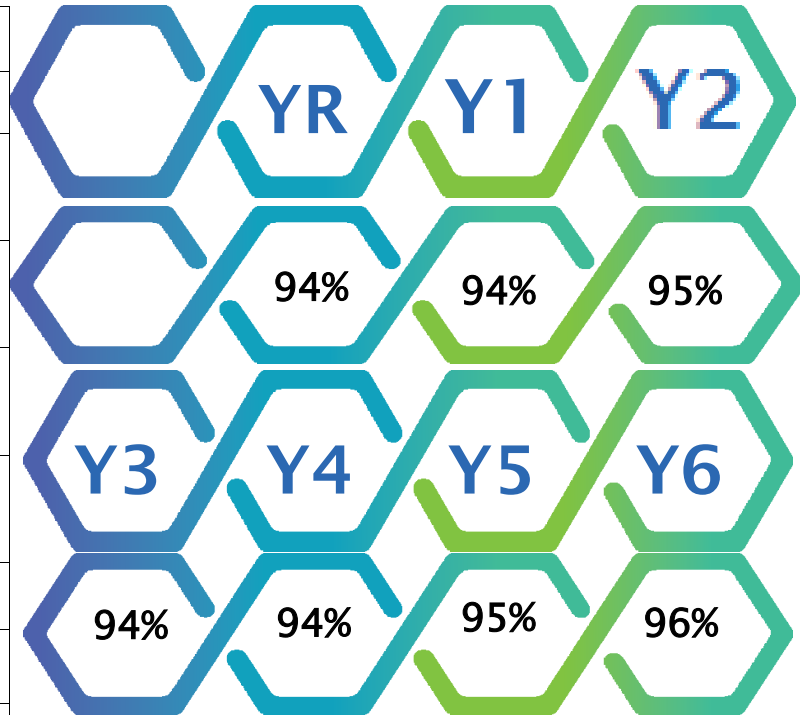
## After School Clubs

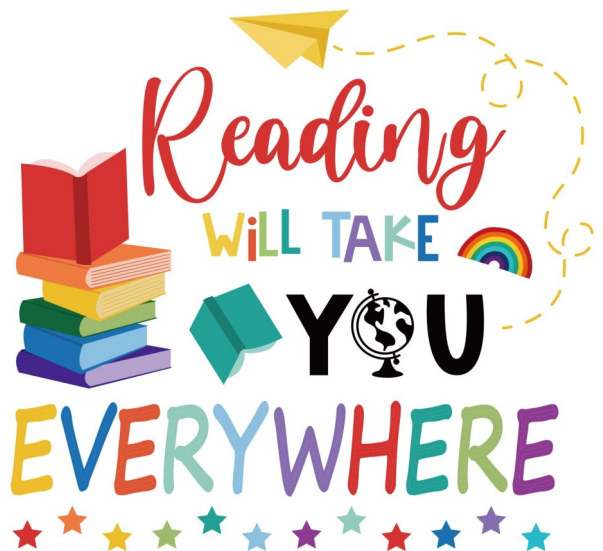
