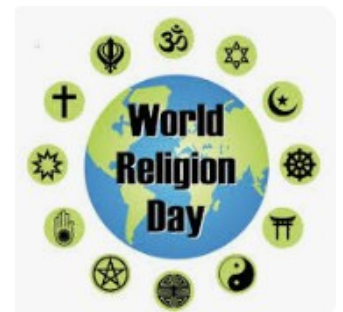

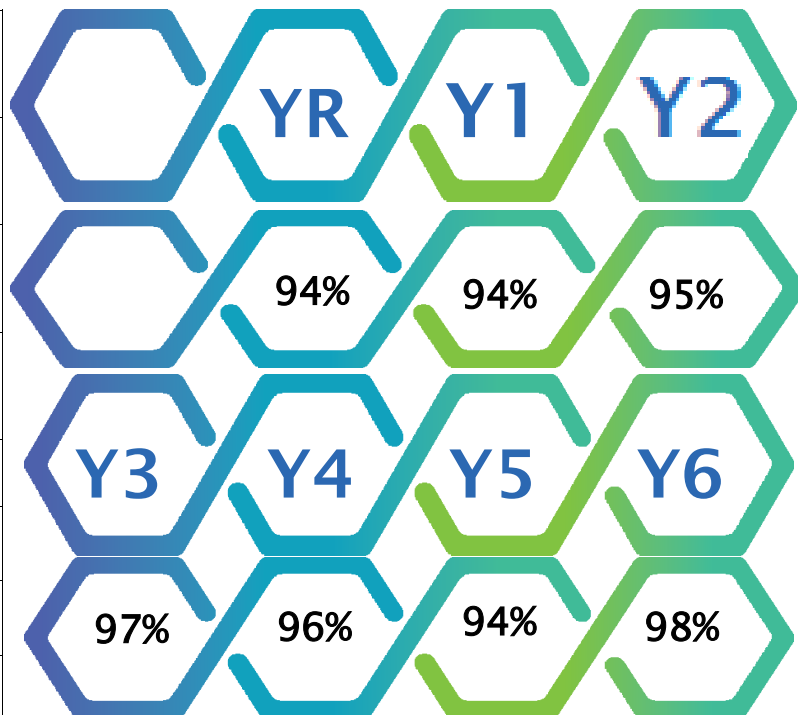

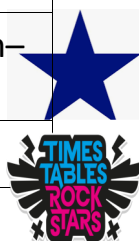
## Attendance
