
A huge well done to our youngest pupils, who were amazing in the Easter bonnet parade. Their creativity, enthusiasm and big smiles made it such a joyful event.

Our school photographs will be taken on Thursday 23rd April in the school hall. If you want to have a family photograph, these can be taken before school at 8.30am.




