Nut Free School

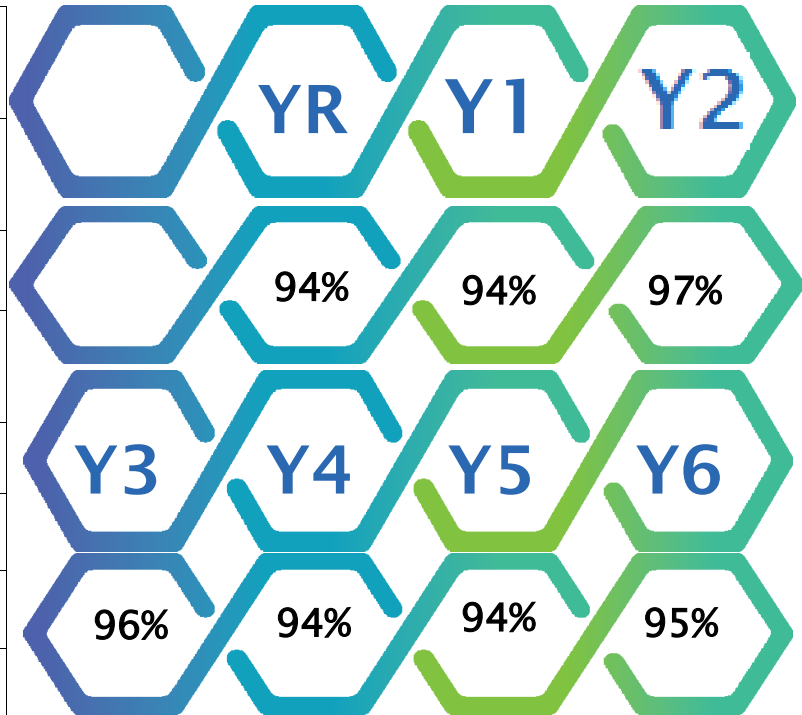
Due to a significant number of children with allergies, there must be no nuts or nut products brought into school. This of course will include Nutella spread and chocolate bars that contain nuts.



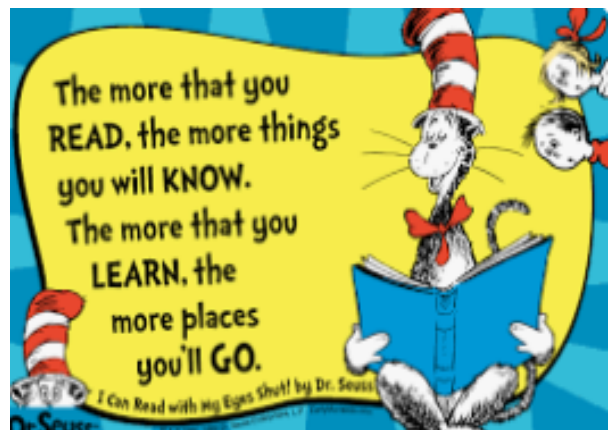
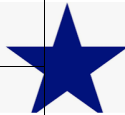
