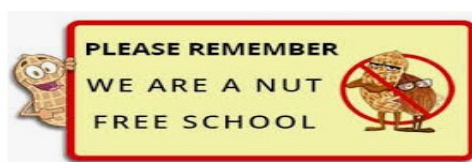


School Uniform

Sports Day

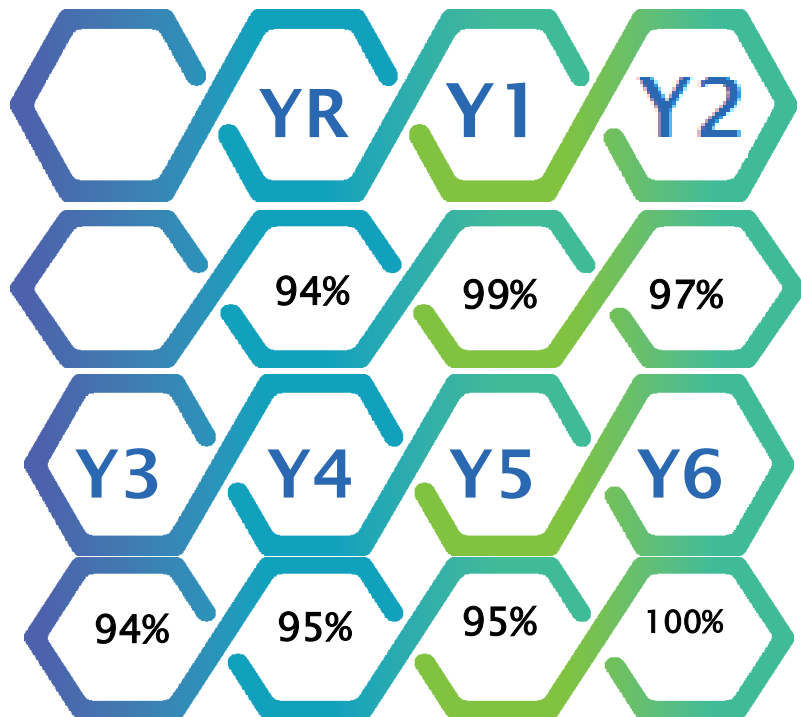
