## Football Themed Non-Uniform Day

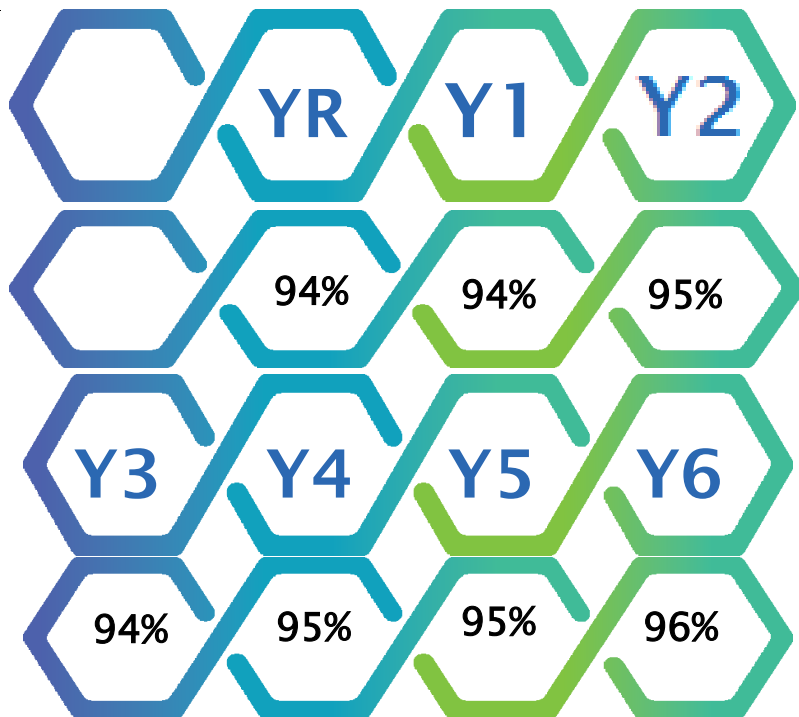

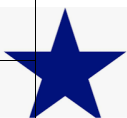
