Car Parking

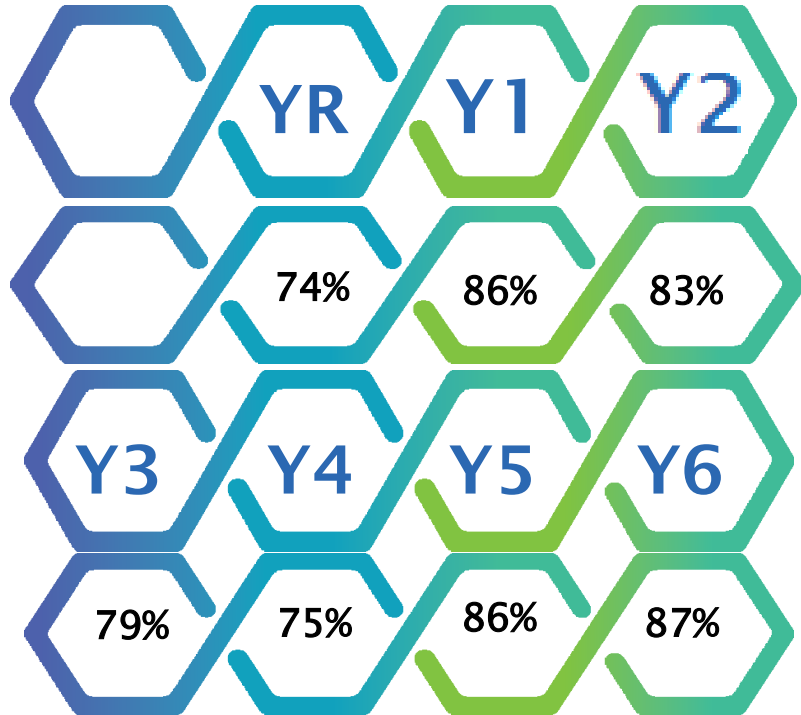
