Blue – St Andrew Yellow – St David Red – St George Green – St Patrick

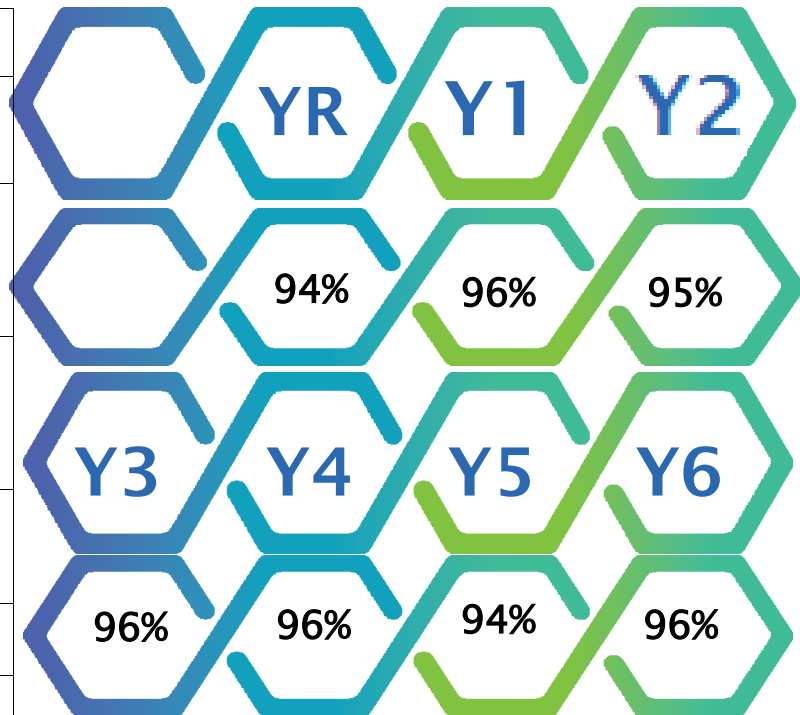
