Attendance Matters

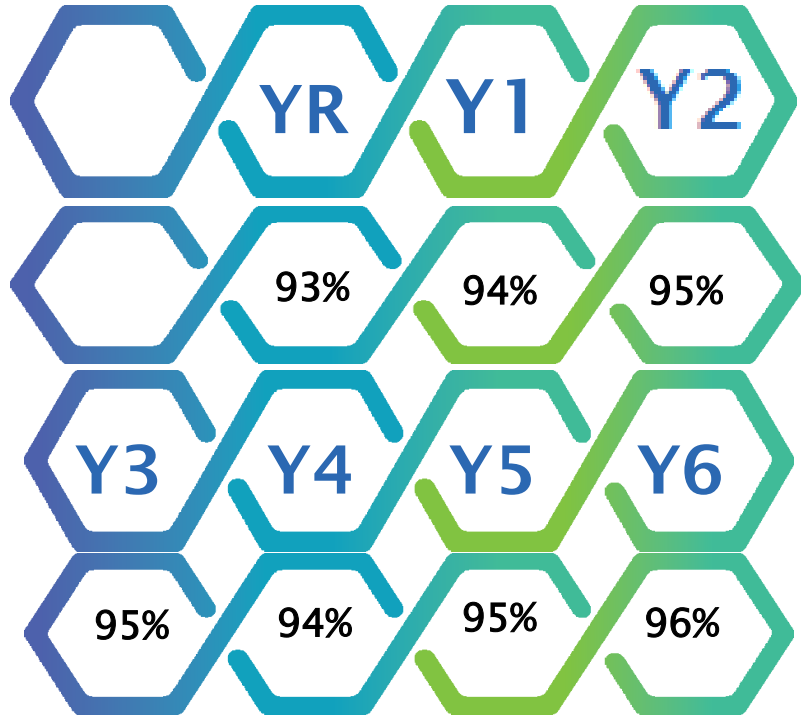

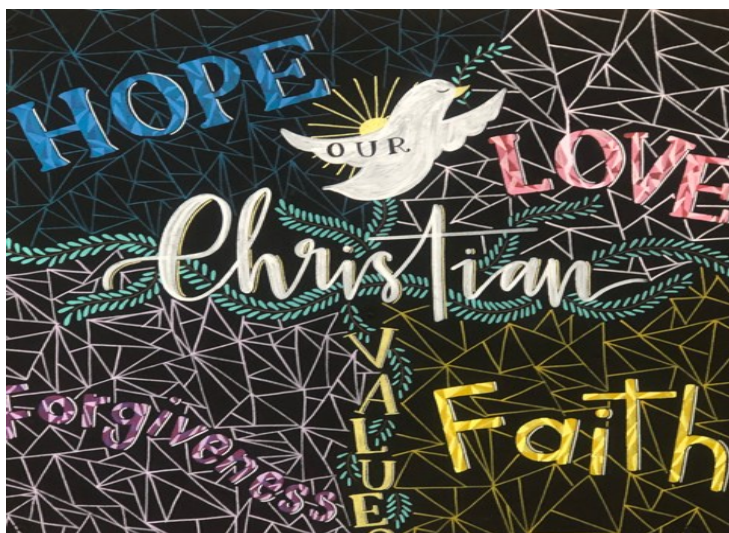
