Parking

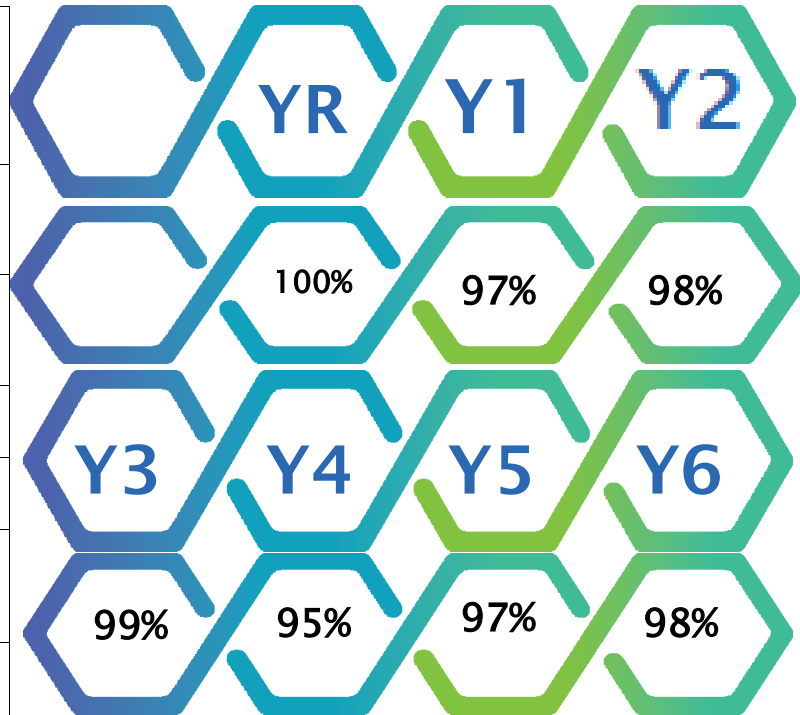
As a polite reminder please do not park directly in front of the school gates at any time, as access must be kept clear for safety and emergency purposes.

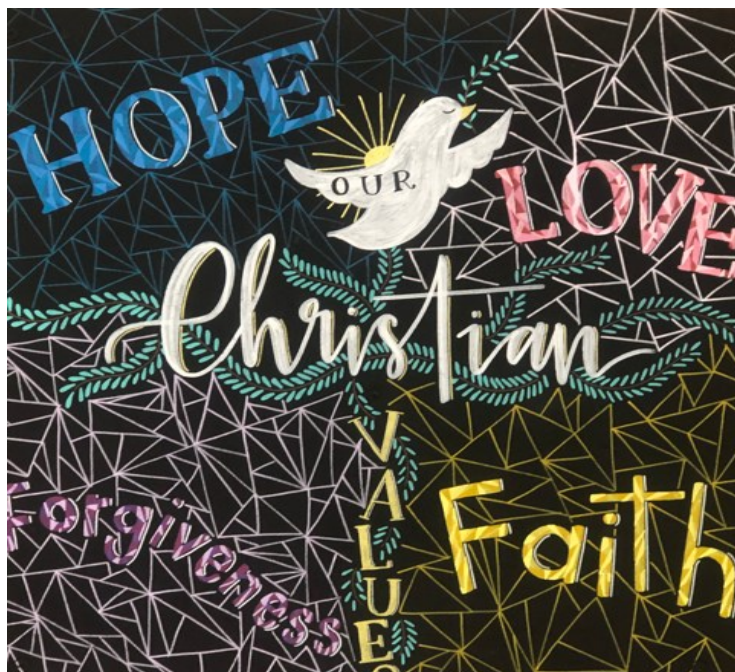
Attendance
